**GOVERNING BODY COMMENTS**

**Mayor Myhre**-Wished all a Happy New Year and stated 2022 is now behind us and is focused on making 2023 a great year. Mayor reviewed funding and grants received, Improvements for biking and walking. Principal forgiveness from the state I-bank for Sewer Rehab, nearly 5 million for the Stafford Branch of the Ocean County Library. Schedule C work with Ocean County and NJDOT road work on Rt. 72 and the Bridge and Rt. 9 Manor Shop project. He also announced working with Congressman Van Drew to secure \$2 million in funding for Stafford Township's proposed improvement to Route 72 and Route 9.

**Councilman Steadman**-Reported on the December 2022 Building and Zoning Department. 172 Construction permits were issued, 1,180 inspections were completed, 75 zoning permits were issued and 13 Certificates of occupancy issued for new single family dwellings. Certificates of Occupancy were issued for The Friendly Sons of the Shillelagh and Manafirkin Brewery. Dunkin Donuts on Rt. 72 is now open.

**Councilwoman Mower**-The next Green Team meeting will be on Monday January 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. Stafford Township has been selected as one of the pilot communities for the 2022-2023 Mayors Wellness Mental Health Initiative. More news to come on the program in the coming months.

**Councilman Henken**-Wished all Happy and prosperous New Year. The Stafford Recreation and PBA 297 Toy and Coat Drive was a great success. We had great support from local business and residents. We were able to help over 300 families. He thanked all for volunteering. Winter Coat Drive is ongoing.

**Councilman Krier**-No report but wished all a Happy and Prosperous New Year.

**Councilwoman Otte**-Reported on the activities of the Stafford Township EMS for the month. Year to date calls are 3,678. The EMS has begun their recruitment process. Information is available on the Stafford EMS website: [www.squad38.com/recruitment](http://www.squad38.com/recruitment). Animal Control has responded to a total of 146 calls. Free Rabies Clinic will be held on February 25<sup>th</sup> here at the Water/Sewer Garage behind Town Hall. Southern Ocean County Animal Facility is asking for donations of Nyla bones and blankets. The Fire Department is requesting residents to adopt a fire hydrant to keep clear of debris or snow. She wished all a Happy New Year.

**Councilman Esposito**-Reported on the Public Works Department. The Road Division, swept multiple miles, cleaned and repaired storm drain inlets and pot hole repair. Repair and maintenance to drain pipes, and assistance to the Building and Grounds in various projects. The Sanitation Department picked up 2 million 506.04 tons of bulk. 
