# Proclamation

**PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**  
**TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF**  
**STAFFORD AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS AND**  
**BUREAUS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE**  
**TOWNSHIP OF STAFFORD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by (Chapter 251 of the laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App. A:9-30 et. seq.; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 (6), and ordinances enacted pursuant thereto; N.J.S.A. 2C:33-1 et. seq.;- whichever law or laws apply), **Executive Order 103, 107 and 108** and by ordinances adopted by the Township of Stafford, I have declared that a **STATE OF EMERGENCY** exists within the Township of Stafford; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, and regulations as are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may be presented by such an emergency; and


WHEREAS, all lands within the boundaries of the Township of Stafford are hereby designated as disaster areas; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Stafford will open all parks for recreation, Friday, May 22, 2020. In addition, bathrooms in the Parks will reopen as well. Masks will be required to enter the bathrooms and signs will be posted in all parks to practice social distancing. Tennis and pickle ball courts are now open with singles only or doubles where the partners live in the same household. Playground equipment, pavilions and basketball courts will continue to be closed. Jennifer Lane Bay Beach will open on June 15, 2020, with social distancing being practiced and capacity limited to 50% of the beach area.


